It is decided

Article Two: The Committee performs its mandate and tasks in accordance with Law No. (116) of 2013 and its Executive regulations referred to above.

Article Three: The duration of the Committee is one calendar year renewable.

Article Four: The remuneration for the members of the Committee and any external parties resorted should be paid in accordance with the provisions and regulations governing this.

Article Five: This decision is executed and abided by as of the date of its issuance; and shall be published in the Official Gazette.
